Dear Members,

Subject : Details of Vendors providing E-seals as per Circular 36/2017-Customs & 37/2017-Customs

This refers to our earlier circular ref. no. Plexh/Cir/1373 dated 26th September, 2017 regarding Clarifications on RFID Electronic Seals under Self Sealing Procedure Implementation Deferred till 1st Nov 2017. In the same circular it was informed that in order to ensure that electronic seals deployed are of a reliable quality, the Board has adopted international standards laid down under ISO 17712:2013 for high security seals and prescribed that all vendors proposing to offer RFID Tamper Proof One-Time-Bolt Container Seals to exporters for self-sealing, must submit self-attested certificates from seal manufacturers to the Director (Customs), CBEC, North Block, New Delhi before commencing sales. Where the certification is found to comply with the requirements of the ISO standard, the names of such vendors shall be put up on the Board's website (www.cbec.gov.in) for ease of reference of the trade and field formations, as soon as they are received.

Members please note that it is ongoing process of verifying the documents of the Vendors. As and when aspiring vendors complete the required documentation their names will be put up on CBEC website. Same will also be updated from our side to members.

- Applicants may please note that the process of verifying the documents of the Vendors is an ongoing process. As and when aspiring vendors complete the required documentation their names will be put up on CBEC website. Other desirous vendors may submit the

- documents, duly self-attested, as prescribed under the Board's Circulars to Director (Customs), Room No. 227 B, North block, New Delhi with a copy on email dircus@nic.in.
2. The vendors as mentioned in List B have been informed by e-mail regarding the deficiencies in their documents. They are advised to submit the same at the earliest.
 3. Vendors in List A, whose complete set of documents have been received would be informed separately by a letter wherein terms & conditions would be mentioned. Those vendors are required to adhere to all requirements as mentioned in Circulars 26/2017, 36/2017 & 37/2017. Any non-observance to such conditions would lead to disqualification of that vendor.
 4. Vendors have to provide RFID readers at the ports/ICDs under intimation to the CBEC. They are advised to install the same at the Ports/ICDs and intimate the list of such ports/ICDs to CBEC to their potential customers i.e. Exporters. The department reserves the right to direct vendor to provide reader at any Customs port/ICD.
 5. As exporters have to purchase e-seals directly from the vendors, they are advised to take appropriate precautions with regards to the financial transactions or any other dealings with the Vendor. The department is in no way responsible for the conduct of the vendor.
 6. The vendor has to ensure that the transaction history of the self-sealing should be visible to the exporters for their reference.
 7. The vendor shall ensure that the Tag identification (TID) number is captured in their data base and the IEC code of the exporter is linked to the same at the time of sale of the seals. Upon reading at the port/ICD, the software application, provided by the vendor, shall ensure that the seal's identity is checked with its TID.
