Sub : Inputs on rules of origin under the proposed India-Mauritius Comprehensive Economic Cooperation and Partnership Agreement (CECPA)

This has reference to communication received from Ministry of Commerce and Industry regarding Inputs on rules of origin under the proposed India-Mauritius Comprehensive Economic Cooperation and Partnership Agreement (CECPA)

One of the tracks in the CEPCA would be the rules of origin. These are rules conferring the origin to goods for availing of tariff (or customs duty) preferences for exports under the proposed CECPA. These could include criteria such as wholly originating, change in tariff classification (CTC), value addition, any technical rule etc.

In this context, members are kindly requested to provide inputs at the HS 6 digit level on the possible rules of origin under the India-Mauritius CECPA with adequate justification in the following format by 12.1.2017 to the undersigned at bharti@plexconcil.org ;
