



Dear ED,

Please refer to the email sent by the EP- CAP Section on 11th August, 2017 for incorporating the recommendation of the Madhusudan Committee Report in the Article of Association/bye laws by the EPCs. Then on 7th September, 2017 I have sent another mail in which few information has been sought and also directions has been given that without furnishing the information no EPC should go ahead with election. Then following our direction Plexconcil has deferred the election and conducted the urgent CoA meeting on 22nd September, 2017 in Mumbai, however Capexil went ahead with the election without furnishing the complete information. Then on 20 September, 2017 an email was received from Joint DGFT, Kolkata who was acting as Chairman of the Election Committee for conducting the election of Capexil in which he has raised the issue of Madhusudan Committee recommendations and also brought to our notice some problem related to the election/E voting and he has sought the direction of this Department. Then on 21st September, 2017 a direction has been given by DoC to the Joint DGFT for not declaring the result of the election held in Capexil and also sought the explanation from Shri R.K. Mittal, Chairman Capexil but no response has been received from him.

Now it has been decided with the approval of Commerce Secretary that the election held in the Capexil and the proposed election which was scheduled in Plexconcil shall now stand cancelled and all EPCs shall incorporate the complete recommendations of the Madhusudan Committee Report and then they will conduct the election for all the vacant posts as per the amended AoA/bye laws and specifically they will ensure that candidates those will contest the election would be fulfilling the eligibility criteria means two years of cooling period has to be availed by the candidate after serving as CoA members for continuous period of 4 years.

Kindly take immediate steps in this regard and incorporate the recommendations within a week and submit the same to this department for approving the amended AoA/Bye laws.
